Lions show appreciation to St John for hall use

FARNHAM Lions Club has been running free first aid life saving courses in the community for more than two years, under the banner 'Heartstart Farnham Lions'.

For most of this time St John Ambulance has allowed the instruction team to use the hall at St John House in Farnham, free of charge, for twice-monthly classes.

Both organisations share the same aim of teaching people how to preserve the lives of unfortunate casualties of accidents or serious health afflictions.

Farnham Lions Club wanted to demonstrate its gratitude for the use of this well-appointed facility in some tangible way and agreed with the St John staff that the most appropriate way would be by the provision of communications

radio equipment. This is particularly appropriate as St John staff provide first aid cover for other community events such as Farnham Carnival, an event in which Farnham Lions Club is also involved with, and which requires efficient radio communication between first aiders across the town.

St John Ambulance has now allocated twice-monthly dates throughout 2015 when Heartstart Farnham Lions can continue their classes in the hall, building on their achievement of 350 plus members of the public trained so far.
