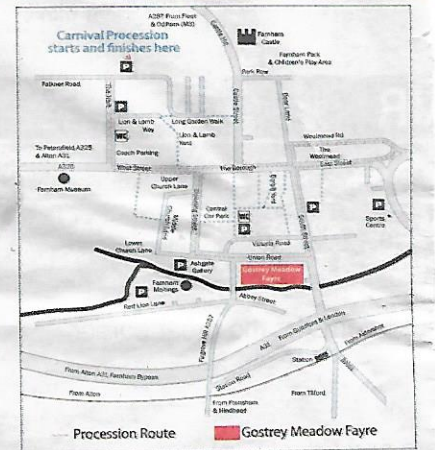


# Farnham Carnival
