On Course Safety

Please ensure that you have read the separate Safety sheet related to Covid 19 and that all protocols are observed during your day here.

Action to be taken in the event of Lightning

- If there is a risk of lightning, play must be discontinued whether or not the siren has been sounded.
- Play is automatically discontinued on the sound of a single long blast of the siren followed by a break of 30 seconds another single long blast.
- All Players, ball-spotters etc should immediately proceed to the club house.
- Players may not override the decision to cease play under these circumstances.
- In competition players should mark their ball where it lies and then lift it.
- Play will be resumed by two short blasts of the siren followed by a break of 30 seconds another two short blasts.

Action to be taken in the event of being bitten by a snake

- It has been reported that Adders have been seen on the course
- DO NOT KILL ANY THAT YOU SEE AS THEY ARE A PROTECTED SPECIES

Hindhead Golf Club



Situated about one and a half miles north of the A3 trunk road, this gem of a course, rated as the 36th best of England's more than 2000 courses, is a must for every golfer, whatever their handicap.

The Hindhead Golf Club was formed in 1904 when a small group of enthusiasts, including Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, began the task of converting barren moorland into the course that members and visitors alike enjoy today. Each member of the famous triumvirate of J H Taylor, James Braid and Harry Vardon

played exhibition matches here, as did Ted Ray, another Open Champion. Dai Rees was the third professional to be engaged at Hindhead (1938 - 1947) and he credited the narrow fairways for his accurate driving.

Illustrious names have appeared on the membership list: Lloyd George, R. C. Robertson Glasgow, The Maharaja of Baroda and Peter Alliss – The Voice of Golf, one of Britain's most successful professional golfers and much missed by all at Hindhead GC.



One of Hindhead's unique features is the contrast between the two halves of the course. The holes from the second to the ninth follow the valleys formed during the Ice Age. The narrowness of the fairways, together with the slopes of heather and trees, add not only to the challenge of the game but also to the sheer breathtaking beauty of the course. The last nine, on the other hand, are laid out on an upper plateau more in keeping with traditional heathland courses. The fairways on these holes appear

wide after the previous valley terrain. They may seem to allow all the room you want for a good drive but beware, appearances can be deceptive!

Hindhead is not excessively long at something over 6,300 yards. However, the challenge of the terrain coupled with the excellent condition, in which the course is invariably presented by the Club's professional greens-staff, poses a fine test for all golfers.
